Kit List:

- Game 1: Blindfolds, cones (cones can be collected from Church Collective office)
- Game 2: Sheep cut out with with letters on and put around park (can be collected from Church Collective office)
- Game 3: Wrapping paper, scissors and sellotape
- General: Party blowers/party poppers, a doll baby, swaddling cloth.

People to bring:

- Picnic blanket, drinks, their own snacks, blindfolds if they have their own.

Instructions:

Orange text = instructions.

Black text = narrator or character to read

Bold text = for everyone to say

Songs and Games are optional.

Narrator 1	Welcome everyone with words such as
	My name is (Narrator 1) and I will be narrating our story today and on the other side is my friend (Narrator 2).
Narrator 1	We want to create an action for each of our characters, so when you hear that character being called out, you can perform that action - even if you aren't that character, it doesn't matter. Step forward if you are a go through one by one as directed in the next 7 rows Mary, Joseph, Animal, Shepherd, Star, King, etc.
Narrator 1	Let's give a great big 'Blessed are you among women!' for, who will be leading our Marys. Everyone shouts 'Blessed are you among women'
	Decide on an action for Mary

Narrator 2	And let's give a great big 'No need to worry!' for, who will be leading our Josephs.
	Everyone shouts 'No need to worry'
	Decide on an action for Joseph
Narrator 2	And let's give a great big, 'MOO! BAAA! HEEHAW!' for, who will be leading our animals.
	Everyone shouts 'MOO! BAAA! HEEHAW!!'
	Decide on the actions for the animals
Narrator 1	And let's give a great big, 'Surprise! Don't be afraid!' for, who will be leading our angels.
	Everyone shouts 'Surprise! Don't be afraid'
	Decide on the action for the angels
Narrator 1	And let's give a great big, 'Don't be afraid? Are you baa-rmy' for, who will be leading our shepherds.
	Everyone shouts 'Don't be afraid? Are you baa-rmy'
	Decide on the action for the shepherds
Narrator 2	And let's give a great big, 'Safe travels, remember your carry on!' for, who will be leading our kings.
	Everyone shouts, 'Safe travels, remember your carry on!'
	Decide on the action for the kings.
Narrator 2	And, finally, let's give a great big, 'Twinkle Twinkle Little Star!' for, who will be the Star leading our Star-watchers.'
	Everyone shouts 'Twinkle Twinkle Little Star!'
	Decide on the action for the star
SONG	O Come All Ye Faithful'
Narrator 1	Everyone needs a party blower - every time that God does something AMAZING! we will be blow it. When I shout AMAZING, we blow it - lets practise.
	we blow it - lets practise.

Narrator 1	Are we ready for our story? Well this story is totally AMAZING! And it starts with an Angel (perform agreed action) suddenly appearing to Mary (action). Get the Angels to jump out, and surprise any Mary's.
Narrator 1	Mary (action) was terrified, maybe it was the suddenness of his arrival. Maybe it was the shock of the surprise, or maybe because the Angel (action) said
Narrator 2 and Angels	Hello, Favoured One! God is with you.
Narrator 1	Mary (action) was a young woman from a little town called Nazareth, in the region of Galilee. She had never expected anything like this to happen to her. What did the angel (action) mean? What was this all about? She was confused and troubled, (Mary to looks confused and troubled!) to say the least. And the angel (action), Gabriel, understood that.
Narrator 2 and Angels	Don't be afraid. This is a good thing! God is pleased with you and wants to do something amazing for you. So here is what's going to happen: You will give birth to a son called Jesus. He will be great. In fact, he will be called the Son of God.' AMAZING!
Narrator 2 and the Mary's	Then let him do this "impossible" thing for me. I will be his servant and do what he has asked.' AMAZING!
Narrator 1	Then, just as suddenly as the Angel (action) arrived, they disappeared. (Angels and Marys go back to their spaces)
	Joseph (action) heard the news (all the Josephs step forward). It was the last thing that Joseph (action) wanted to hear. Mary, (action) the woman he had promised to marry, was expecting a baby.
	And there was no way that the baby was his.
	All the Josephs shake their heads.
	What could Joseph (action) do?
	Joseph (action) went to bed still thinking about what he could do. He fell asleep (Joseph pretends to go to sleep) and then suddenly, AMAZING(LY)! an Angel (action) appeared to him and said: (Angels come out again)

Narrator 2 and Angels	Joseph! (action) Don't be afraid to marry Mary (action). She has not been unfaithful to you. The baby she is expecting is there by the power of God's own Holy Spirit. She is going to give birth to a son. And God wants you to call him Jesus, for just as that name means, he will rescue his people from their sins!' AMAZING!
Narrator 1	When Joseph (action) woke up,
	(All the Josephs wake up)
	He did exactly what the angel (action) told him and took Mary (action) as his wife. (Mary and Josephs stand next to each other, looking happy!) They made their preparations to make a long journey as the Roman ruler, Augustus, wanted to find out how many people were in his vast empire. So he ordered everyone under his control to return to their hometown to be counted. So Mary and Joseph loaded their donkey and set off to Bethlehem. (Mary and Joseph pretend to go on a journey)
GAME	Get into teams and choose 1 person to be a donkey. Blind fold the donkey, set up cones in a circuit and then the other within the team direct the donkey around the 'circuit'. (Have multiple turns if their are multiple people want a go at being the donkey).

The Messiah, the One God promised you. The one you have been waiting for, year after year after year. He's here!
	'And this is the sign that points to him, so you will know for sure that you have found him: look for a baby, wrapped in cloths fit for a newborn, lying in a manger.'

PRAYER	Lord, help us be like Star-watchers Following your lead Looking for your guidance In every word and deed.
Narrator 1	That is the end of the nativity story, but it is not the end of the Jesus story. Jesus went on to do AMAZING! things in His life. He healed the sick. AMAZING! He gave the blind their sight. AMAZING! He fed people. AMAZING! Transformed people. AMAZING! Offered people eternal life. AMAZING! Loved people. AMAZING! And then He ultimately gave His life up for everyone, to take away our sins and make us pure and spotless in the eyes of God. AMAZING! And the Jesus story doesn't stop there, it carries on. It carries on today, as Jesus lives inside of us through the power of the Holy Spirit. And the Jesus story will continue on and on, until He comes again to judge the living and the dead and His Kingdom will have no end! AMAZING!
